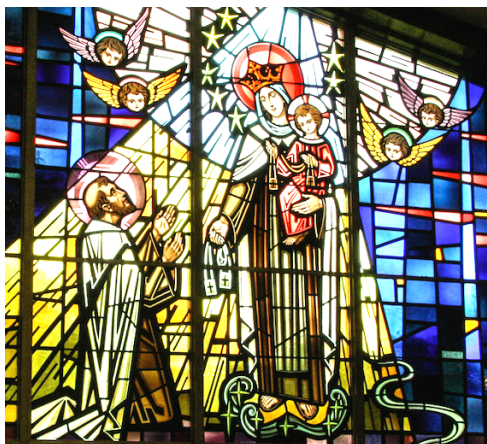

The Blessed Trinity- mystery beyond human reasoning!

"Two's company, three's a crowd" is a popular expression. It is however, otherwise in the mystery of the Blessed Trinity. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit symbolizes completeness and perfect symmetry." In fact, Blessed Trinity is a mystery beyond human understanding. They are three persons in one God. They work inseparably and none co-existed before the other.

The word "Trinity" is absent from Scripture, but the theology behind the word can be found in a surprising number of verses. In the gospel of John, Jesus always speaks that He and Father are One. In addition, before His ascension, He comforted the apostles that He and the Father will send the Holy Spirit-the advocate to comfort, to testify and to stand with them. "The doctrine of the Trinity can be summarized in seven statements. (1) There is only one God. (2) The Father is God. (3) The Son is God. (4) The Holy Spirit is God. (5) The Father is not the Son. (6) The Son is the not the Holy Spirit. (7) The Holy Spirit is not the Father. The Persons are not three gods; rather, they dwell in communion with each other as they subsist in the divine nature without being compounded or confused."

We begin and end our Mass invoking the Blessed Trinity. "Just think of what that simple gesture means. We touch our heads for the Father – the one whose mere idea, whose smallest thought, created us. This is where we began, in the mind of God. We touch our hearts for the Son – the one whose unceasing love took him to the cross, and the one who taught us, as well, how to love through his own Sacred Heart. We touch our shoulders for the Holy Spirit – the one who gives us strength, and who carries us on His shoulders — on His wings if you will – and who enables us to be God's arms, working on earth. The Three Persons in the Trinity, the Father the Son and the Holy Spirit together represent the fullness of love and unity." Our lives can only mirror the Blessed Trinity only when we live in peace and unity.
